

Adult Leader Responsibilities



Thank you for coming, your assistance today is most appreciated.

- Supervise students at all times.
- Notify the teacher or Village staff if you are unable to locate a missing student.
- Assist the guides where necessary.
- Encourage responsible and safe student behaviour;
 - No running
 - Ask before you touch
 - Do not touch anything behind the rope
 - Do not climb on the train engine or coal truck
 - Do not jump off the train or station platform
- Be respectful of other visitors
- Get the most out of the Village's exhibits and activities
 - Encourage the students questions about the exhibits and activities
 - Relate stories from your childhood or from grandparents recollections.
- Encourage the students to read exhibit labels and information panels.
- Check with the teachers about which areas they would like to focus on.
- Enjoy your visit.

Other Important Information

- Food & drink should not be consumed in the buildings.
- Toilets are located adjacent to the library, children must be supervised.
- Photography is permitted and encouraged.
